

The Sixth State Reform enters into force. New powers are conferred on the Regions and Communities. A new financing model is initiated. It is a turning point in the history of Belgium. The centre of gravity in the Belgian federal system shifts in the direction of the Regions and Communities. This is why the legislator reforms the Federal Parliament as well. From now on, one assembly will look after the interests of the substates at the federal level.:

SUBSTATE SENATORS**


The substate senators are members of a substate parliament and of the Senate. Their mandate of senator is non-remunerated.

Appointed by the substate senators. The co-opted senators are paid half of a parliamentary remuneration.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The Constitution stipulates that the Senate is a non-permanent body. The Senate meets less often than other assemblies. There are 10 plenary sessions per year. The committees meet every two weeks.

Information reports are extensive reports on policy issues in which the State and the Regions and Communities have to cooperate with, or consult or at least inform each other so as to be able to pursue a coherent policy.



ADOPTED ENACTMENTS & BILLS



On the legislative front, the Senate retains responsibility only for laws that concern the fundamental organization and functioning of the federal State and its components.

Examples:

THE CONSTITUTION

Extension of the detention period from 24 to 48 hours

SPECIAL MAJORITY LAWS

Extension of the constitutive autonomy



ORDINARY LAWS

Declaration of mandates and assets by elected officials

RESOLUTIONS



Examples:

- Employment of persons with disabilities on the regular labour market
- Dr Ahmadreza Djalali, who has been sentenced to death in Iran
- Pollution of the North Sea - Microplastics in cosmetics
- Extension of the 30-km zone
- Fight against anti-Semitism
- Simple and informative income tax return
- Total ban of the ivory trade



5 REASoNED OPINIoNS ON CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Sometimes, a parliament holds that its interests are infringed by the discussion of a proposal or bill in another parliament. If they cannot settle their dispute by consultation, the Senate issues a reasoned opinion.

Examples:

- Untaxed additional income
- Quotas for care providers








